“ Hey Champ,

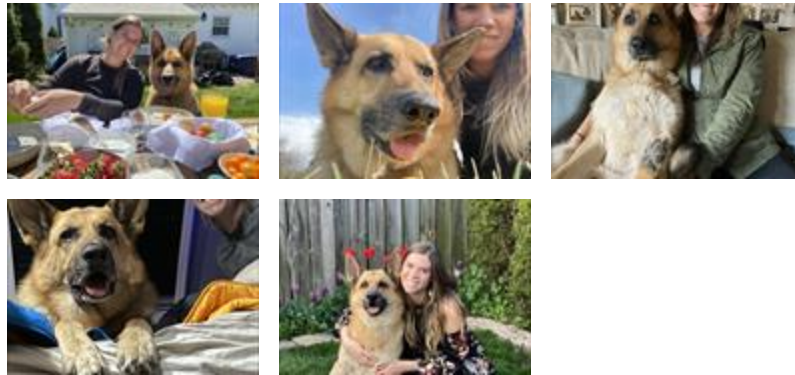
