February 1, 2007 - May 28, 2021

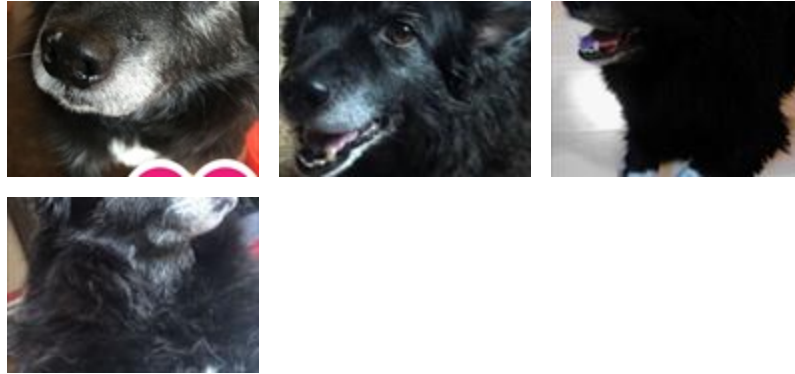
