Toady passed away on May 5, 2025 after a battle with kidney disease and some other health issues. Amphibians are good at hiding their illnesses, and by the time she was diagnosed, it was not reversible. She was still eating bugs, sometimes over 10 in one sitting, up until the end of November, and it was several weeks later when she stopped eating and became lethargic that I realized something was very wrong. Some treatments were attempted and vet visits managed her symptoms for a while, but her disease was progressive and terminal. She took her medications, daily baths, and nutrition bravely for months until it was time for her to go. She liked exploring, digging, hiding under plant leaves and dark areas, and crickets and waxworms. She was sensitive to different sounds and would hide when she heard certain voices she didn't like. She was about the size of a quarter when I first found her on my doorstep one day - the smallest crickets at the store were too big and they had to pick out the smallest ones out of those for her. At one point she could gulp down the largest size crickets. She was an unexpected small toad friend who came into my life one day and lived with me for over four years, and will be missed.
