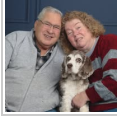
Thank you, Pastor April. Waffles loved getting to visit with everyone; it was hard for him to contain his excitement. He definitely was special and loved.

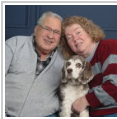
